GENERAL SHOW RULES

The Show is run under the Contour Exhibitions & Events Ltd rules

- All competitors take part at their OWN RISK and are expected to exercise due care at all times and obey all notices displayed.
- The organisers accept NO responsibility for any accident, loss or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals or property. It shall be a condition of entry that competitors will hold the organisers blameless and indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings.
- Contour recommends that all exhibitors should have adequate personal sports insurance. All accidents/incidents/falls should be reported to the vent organiser.
- The Judges decision will be final.
- The organisers may alter or cancel the competition as they see fit without prior notice.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry of persons or ponies at the Secretary's discretion and without assigning a reason.
- Objections must be in writing and given to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the competition and accompanied with a fee of £10.00 (refundable if the objection is upheld).
- Correct riding hats must be worn at all times to comply with current safety standards.
- No rider may ride more than one horse in the competition.
- Age as at the day of the competition.
- There will be an un-mounted prize giving – riders should be correctly dressed for this.
- The organisers reserve the right to restrict or refuse any entry.
- There will be a tack check.
- The competition will be run according to the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2017. We recommend that competitors read these rules, which are accessible on the Pony Club website.
- Dress code: Jacket and tie required and plain numnahs.

Junior Show Jumping Competition Sunday, 3rd December 2017

The competition, in its fifth year, is open to juniors 14 years and under and ponies 13.2hh and under. There will be places for 15 entrants.

The COMPETITION

Round 1

Each competitor will jump a small course of jumps starting at 70cm

Round 2

Each competitor will jump a small course of jumps of approx. 80cm

All those on an equal first score will go through to Round 3

Round 3

This round will consist of one fence (planks) and the height will be approx 85cm

All those competitors who clear the fence will go into

Round 4 and there will be no more than five rounds

Final placings will be determined by an accumulation of style, turnout and jumping points.

THE ROUNDS ARE NOT AGAINST THE CLOCK
